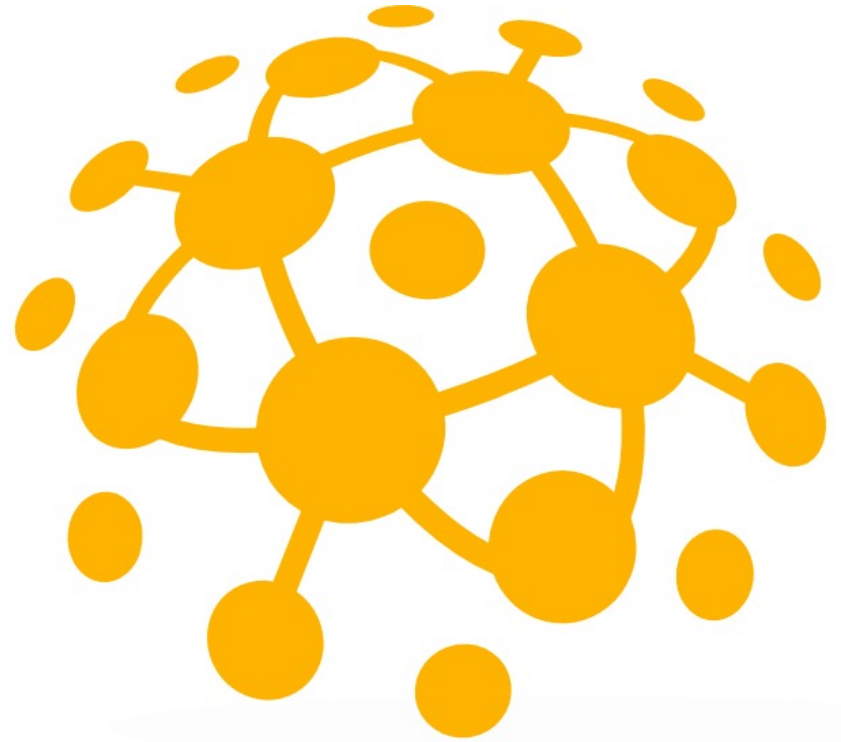

# Spring Meeting of Young Economists (SMYE)

- Well-known conference in Europe for **non-tenured researchers under the age of 35**
- It has been organized since 1996
- Around 700 applications per year
- To maintain a relaxed atmosphere, the number of presenters is always below 200
- Consequently, admittance to the conference is highly competitive



# Spring Meeting of Young Economists (SMYE)

## Selection procedure

- Call for Papers sent out to Graduate Schools and previous SMYE submitting authors
- Each submitted paper is evaluated by several previous SMYE participants within their area and method of expertise
- The invitation to present at the SMYE is based on the average score of these evaluations
- No discretionary decision by the EAYE Board
- Papers submitted by EAYE Board members go through the same procedure

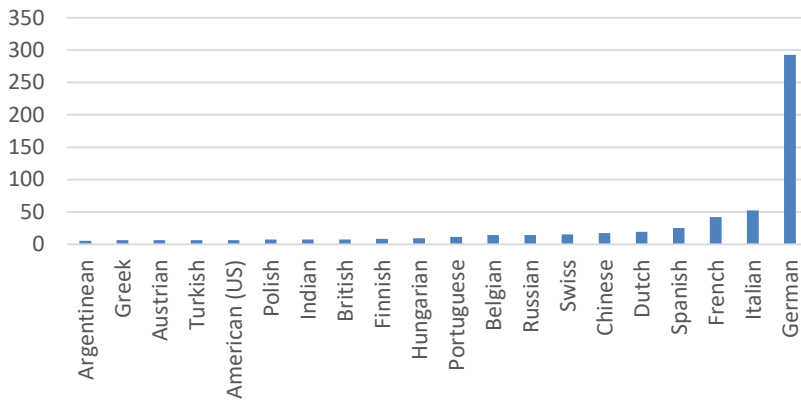
# Spring Meeting of Young Economists (SMYE) 2018

## Key Statistics

- 23% of papers accepted
  - Submitted / accepted papers: 663 / 155
  - A total of 1977 reviews in 2018
- Gender: Submitted / accepted
  - Female: 273 / 55 (in %: 41 / 35)
  - Male: 390 / 100 (in %: 59 / 65)
- Young economists: Submitted / accepted
  - With doctor title: 108 / 39 (in %: 16 / 25)
- Method: Submitted / accepted
  - Experimental: 54 / 12 (in %: 8 / 8)
  - Theoretical: 129 / 38 (in %: 19 / 25)
  - Empirical: 480 / 105 (in %: 72 / 68)

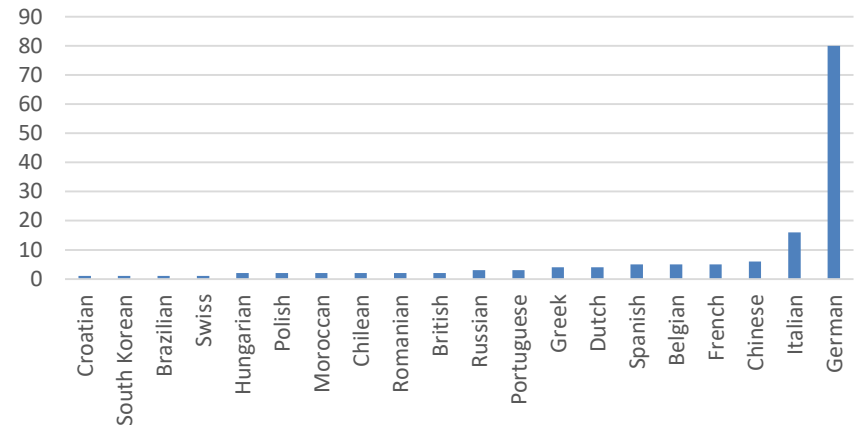
# SMYE 2018 Statistics

Nationality of submitting authors, top 20



Notes: Papers submitted to the 2018 Spring Meeting of Young Economists. 5 papers submitted by authors with Argentinian nationality, 293 by authors with German nationality. **Total number of papers submitted were 663** from authors with **65 different nationalities**.

Notes: Papers accepted for presentation at the 2018 Spring Meeting of Young Economists. **Total number of accepted papers is 155.**

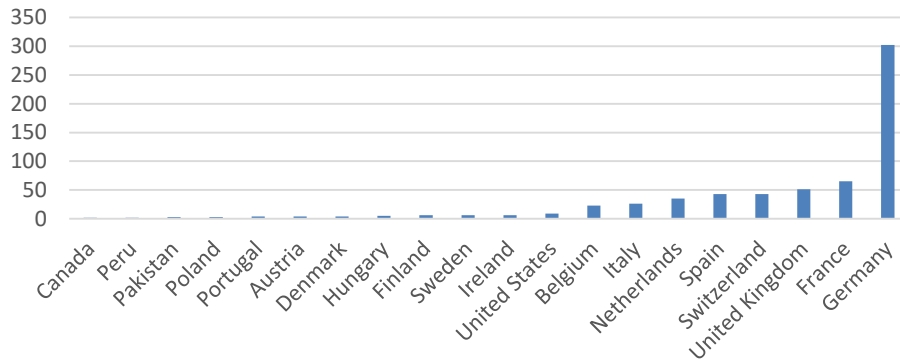
# SMYE 2018 Statistics

- Submitted papers: 386 different institutions
  1. Paris School of Economics: 27 papers
  2. Ifo Institute: 22 papers
  3. Goethe Universität Frankfurt: 14 papers
  
- Presented papers: 114 different institutions
  1. Ifo Institute Munich: 7 papers
  2. Paris School of Economics/DIW Berlin: 6 papers
  3. Universitat Pompeu Fabra: 5 papers



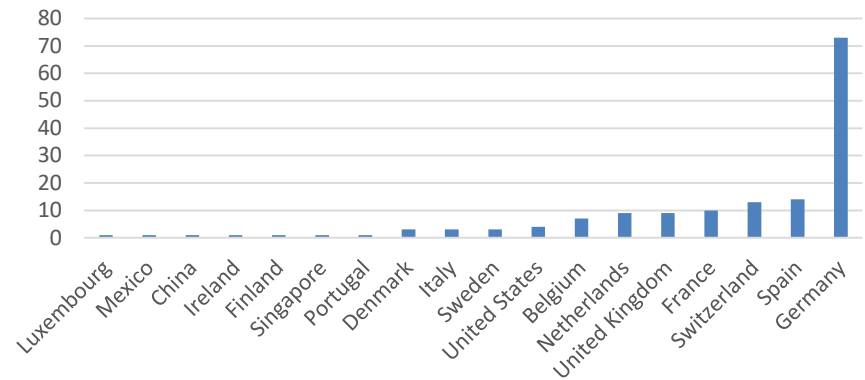
# SMYE 2018 Statistics
